The meetings will be held at 7:00 am, 1:00pm, 3:00pm, and again at the union meeting. If these times don't suit your needs, for example if you are working midnights and you relieve at 6:00am, come to the hall and I will give you the presentation one on one. We need to get this information out to our members. Some of what I will be sharing has been addressed at past union meetings but there are still entirely too many questions out there among our people. For some reason the information is not getting back to all the areas of the mill.

We are currently 285 days past the expiration date of our contract, come to the hall to hear what's going on. **Again I want to stress; this information will not be a repeat of the things you have previously read in the CAT reports.** Please plan on attending.
